All youth (Boys & Girls) playing **baseball** who are at least age 4 by August 31st, 2023 are eligible. Little League regulations require all players to provide proof of age and proof of residency to be eligible to play. Players who reside in, or attend, Big Spring School District are eligible to play in Newville Little League.

NEW Early Bird Registration Fees valid until November 31: T-Ball and Instructional - \$40 per player, all other divisions - \$75 per player, \$50 per sibling. **Registration Fees beginning December 1 through February 4:** T-ball and Instructional - \$50 per player, all other divisions - \$85 per player, \$50 per sibling. **Beginning February 5, a \$25 late fee will be charged per child.** You may also register in person during any of our indoor winter player clinics (see below for dates & times). Checks should be made payable to **Newville Little League**. **All registration and fundraiser monies must be paid by opening day ceremonies or your child will not be eligible to play.** You may register on our website at www.newvillell.org or mail a registration form with payment to Newville Little League at PO BOX 44, Newville, PA 17241-0044.

Sandwich Fundraiser: In addition to registration costs, we require each family to participate in our primary sandwich fundraiser. Each family must sell 30 sandwiches. We are giving parents the opportunity to “buy out” of the sandwich fundraiser by paying an additional \$75 to the League at the time of registration. Sandwich order forms can be downloaded from our website or picked up at any of the Registration dates.

First time players must bring or mail a copy of their certified birth certificate (usually issued by the State Vital Statistics but could also be a US Passport or other Federal Government document). **All Parents MUST provide three forms of proof of residency** at registration from the following list: driver’s license; voter’s registration; school records; welfare records; Federal, state and local records; support payment records; homeowner or tenant property insurance records; and utility bills (i.e., phone, water, electric, etc.) utility bills count as ONE Form of ID.

MANDATORY Evaluations: Players age 5-12 will be evaluated on the following skills: hitting, running, fielding, catching and throwing. Returning players 12 or under who are returning to their Major division teams are exempt from the player evaluations. Please make every effort to help us by bringing your child to one of two player evaluation dates. These evaluations help ensure proper placement based on age and ability level. **Evaluations are MANDATORY** and will be held at Movement Outreach Church, 2 Chestnut Street, Newville, on **February 11 and February 18 from 1 - 2:30 for ages 5, 6, 7 and 2:30 - 4 for ages 8, 9, 10 (and up)**. **If you are unable to attend these sessions, PLEASE contact the Player Agent, Steven Gayman, to arrange an evaluation prior to February 4, 2022. After evaluations, players will be placed in one of the following divisions based on age and/or ability: Tee Ball, Instructional, Minor Divisions (P1 and P2), Major Division (Majors), Intermediate Division (50/70), Junior League or Senior League. Players ages 5 & 6 who have played at least one regular season of Tee Ball may be drafted to play in the Minor P2 division only if the player evaluation results support the ability to play in that division. Some players may be eligible for more than one division (e.g. players may opt to play both Major and Intermediate.) Please ask the Player Agent for more details.

FREE Indoor Winter Clinics: Prior to the season, we offer additional training and development opportunities through a series of clinics which will be held at Movement Outreach Church. These clinics are FREE, and open to anyone wanting to learn more about baseball and get in shape for the season. Clinics are for players league age 4-12 (League Age is the age of the child as of August 31st, 2023). **January 14, 21, 28 and February 4 from 1-2 for ages 4-6, 2-3 for ages 7-8 and 3-4 for ages 9-12.**

Meet the Manager Day: Once teams are selected and Managers are assigned, parents and players will have the opportunity to meet their manager on **February 26**. Time and Location will be announced later.

Team Parent Meeting: Once teams are selected, each team will need to have a team parent. Team parents coordinate volunteers for the concession stand, help communicate/collect fundraiser information and many other items. Time/date/location will be announced later.

Opening Day Ceremonies: Opening day is scheduled for **April 8 at 9 a.m.** this year with games starting on April 3. We ask that all players attend and be in full uniform to be recognized with their teammates.
